Dear Wasco Families,

Over the next few weeks, our School Social Worker, Rebecca Schroeder and School Psychologist, Ashley Potocki will be implementing a series of three lessons focused on sexual abuse prevention. The lessons meet requirements of *Erin's Law*, named after sexual abuse survivor Erin Merryn. This law requires Illinois public schools to implement a prevention-oriented child sexual abuse program in grades Pre K- 12. All schools in District 303 have been implementing Erin's Law throughout the year.
