Orchestra Concert: Friday, May 6th at 7 p.m. STC East High School Norris Cultural Arts Center (NCAC) Students should arrive at 6:30 and enter door 48. Dress clothes-no t-shirts, shorts, tennis shoes or jeans.

Warm weather and appropriate dress code for school-as the temperatures rise, please review the [D303 school dress code, p. 7](#) to ensure your child is dressed appropriately for school, i.e. no short shorts or skirts, no sheer, low cut, strapless or bare/mid-riff tops. Shirts must have sleeves or can be a tank top but must ensure that undergarments are covered. It is recommended that shoes be appropriate for running and playing-flip flops, sandals and other open-toed shoes often cause students to trip/fall and get wood-chips/rocks in them. P.E. shoes cannot be worn outside-therefore if your child wears flip flops/sandals to school, send along play shoes to change into to wear outside to play safely.
