Next **Friday, Oct. 16th** is the 22nd annual STC Kick-a-Thon event. The STC Kick-A-Thon fundraising event is a community event hosted by the drill teams from both North and East High Schools each October during the STC North vs. East High School football game. The STC Kick-A-Thon 2015 beneficiaries are LivingWell Cancer Resource Center in Geneva, Fox Valley Food for Health, and the Fox Valley Chapter of the American Cancer Society.

At the event, which this year will be held at **STC EAST** High School, each D303 school is represented by a staff member who will kick in the Kick-A-Thon and students who will carry their school banner around the field. This year's staff representative is Mrs. Williams, Wasco P.E./Health Teacher. She, along with other D303 kickers, drill team members and community members will kick 100 kicks simultaneously while the crowd cheers them on!

Wasco School is searching for 4 students who will represent Wasco by carrying the school banner around the field. These 4 students must be accompanied to and from the game by a parent/guardian. A permission slip is attached here for parents to read, sign and return to school by this **Thursday, Oct. 8th**. Four names will be randomly drawn at the end of the day **Thursday**. Parents will be notified and more detailed information will be provided to selected students.

Kick-A-Thon Banner Carrier quick facts:

- *Kick-a-thon is at St. Charles East High School on Friday, October 16th.
- *Banner Carrier students and their parent/supervisor should **arrive by 5:45 pm**. Please arrive on time. They will be taking a picture of all of the participants before we walk with the banners. Parking will be limited, so please allow enough time.
- *Please feel free to dress in your school colors or those of your favorite high school.
- *Enter through the "Kick-a-thon entrance." There will be a sign and tents in the area located on the North-East side of football field (right of ticket booth).
- *There will be an announcement at the end of 3rd quarter of the Sophomore game to tell the banner helpers where to meet. Please listen for this!

*We will be lining up in alphabetical order by school name to march the banners around the football field. Elementary schools go first, followed by junior high schools.

*Afterwards, please join us for **dessert** in the Kick-a-thon tents.

*Wasco school will need one student/parent/supervisor who will be responsible for taking the banner back to their school for display.
